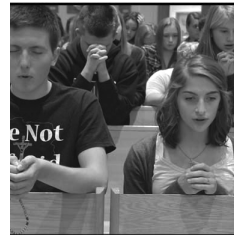

**From the Pastor:** The season of Lent has begun. It is a season of repentance, self-assessment, and conversion. Today is the day to begin to focus on these aspects of Lent. For what actions or words are you already sorry? About what parts of your life do you need to be more aware, more vigilant? How do you want to change your life? And in all these thoughts, processes, and activities how is God present?

One of the ways we can increase our effectiveness in being repentant and seeking conversion is by prayer. I have come to the point in my life where most of my prayers are focused on *awareness*. About what do I need to be *aware* in order to be repentant? About what do I need to be *aware* in order to do an honest assessment of my life? Based on that *awareness* what changes do I need to begin to make in my life in order to make my life more Christ-centered?

## Lenten Regulations

The Lenten season began with Ash Wednesday. As Catholics, we are called to consider our call to holiness and to renew our baptismal promises through attentiveness to the Word of God, prayer and penance. In doing this, we are also called to observe practices, which we do in unity with Catholics throughout the world. These regulations are as follows:

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may only eat one full meal. 2 smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
3. These minimal penitential practices should not be lightly excused.

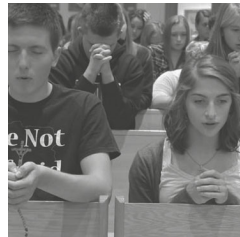

## REGLAMENTO CUARESMA

Esta semana, **Miércoles, 10 de Febrero, es Miércoles de Ceniza** y este día da comienzo a la Cuaresma. Como Católicos debemos considerar nuestro llamado a la santidad y a renovar nuestras promesas bautismales, prestando atención a la Palabra de Dios, oración y penitencia. Al hacer esto, también tenemos la responsabilidad de seguir las practicas, que hacemos en unión con todos los Católicos del mundo. Estos son los reglamento a continuación:

1. Todo católico que ha celebrado los 14 años de edad, deben abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza, y todos los Viernes durante la Cuaresma y Viernes Santo.
2. Además de abstenerse de comer carne, todo católico que tenga 18 años a 59 años de edad, deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo. Aquellos que deseen cumplir este reglamento podrán comer solamente una comida completa. Se permiten dos comidas ligeras si fuera necesario para mantener la fuerza de acuerdo a la necesidad de cada individuo, pero el comer alimentos solidos entre comidas no esta permitido.
3. Estas practicas penitenciales no deben ser tomadas a la ligera.

## Y REFERENTE AL SACRAMENTO DE LA RECONCILIACIÓN:
