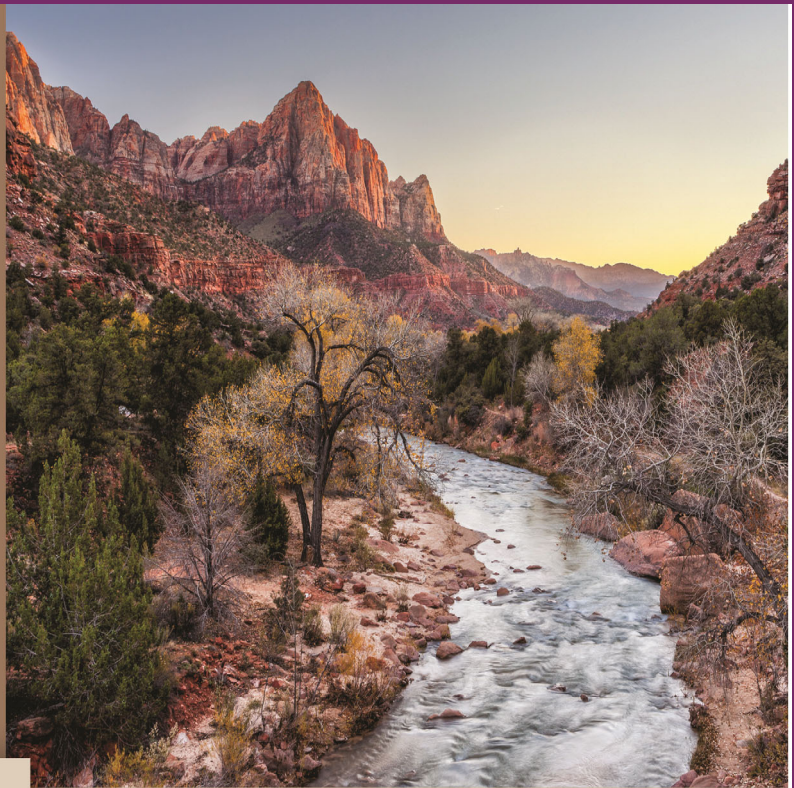

From the Pastor: : Every month, nearly every week, and many days of the year have a designation as times for special “awareness.” The month of March is no exception. March 1 was “Zero Discrimination Day.” How did you do? Were you aware? Do you discriminate?

The purpose of these special awareness times is to raise our consciousness about some issue or group of people about whom there is some perceived lack of awareness. These days or times are also helpful for people who are dedicated to working with particular groups of people or confronting certain shortcomings and failures in society. These collaborators get to celebrate their successes, re-commit themselves to their efforts, and invite others to join.

Another example of a special “awareness” just occurred. Some of you may have been aware that March 6-13 was “National Sleep Awareness Week.” For those who struggle with insomnia or with a propensity to sleep too much, that was an important week. In the last week I have been aware of a couple of studies that say that some groups of people do not get enough sleep. One cause for insufficient sleep is attachment to technology. People sleep with their smart phones in their beds or next to them. They wake in the night to check emails or texts. This is not good for sleep. Lack of adequate sleep can lead to metabolism changes and weight gain, as well as put you at a higher risk for a stroke.

March is also “National Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month,” and March 21 is specifically “World Down Syndrome Day.” As many of you know of my sister Maria has Down Syndrome. You know that raising awareness about these issues is important to me. Some of you remember that four years ago I did the “polar plunge” to raise money for Special Olympics.

Finally, while March 1st was dedicated to zero discrimination, March 21st is “International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination.” Lord knows that we still have work to do. We must raise our awareness of not only how others discriminate, but also about how each of us may still be captured by unhealthy racial discriminatory thoughts or actions. We must remember that no matter how different we may be one from another, we are all beloved creatures of God, every one. Let us be aware! **-Peace, Fr. Andy**

Mensaje de nuestro Párroco: Cada mes, casi cada semana, y muchos días del año, son designados como ocasiones especiales para crear “conciencia.” El mes de Marzo no es la excepción. Marzo 1º fue “Día de Cero Discriminación.” ¿Cómo te fue ese día? ¿Discriminaste ese día?

El propósito de estos días especiales para crear conciencia, es precisamente el despertar nuestras conciencias acerca de ciertos asuntos o grupos de personas, los cuales evidentemente no se les toma en cuenta. Estos días u ocasiones también ayudan a las personas que se dedican a trabajar con ciertos grupos particularmente, o que se enfrentan a ciertos defectos y fallas en la sociedad. Estos colaboradores pueden celebrar sus éxitos, volver a comprometerse a sus obras, e invitar a otros a que se unan a ellos.

Otro ejemplo de días especiales para crear conciencia, acaba de ocurrir. Algunos de ustedes habrán escuchado que del 6 al 13 de Marzo, se llevó a cabo la “Semana Nacional del Sueño.” Para aquellos que sufren de insomnio o que son propensos a dormir demasiado, esa fue una semana importante. Esta semana pasada me percaté de un par de estudios que dicen que algunos grupos de personas no duermen lo suficiente. Una causa de esto es su apego a la tecnología. Muchas personas duermen con sus teléfonos en sus camas o junto a ellas. Se despiertan por la noche a revisar sus emails o textos. Esto no es bueno para su descanso. La falta de sueño adecuado, puede resultar en cambios en el metabolismo y aumento de peso, además de que esto también significa un riesgo más alto de sufrir un infarto.

Marzo es el “Mes Nacional de Incapacidad en el Desarrollo,” y Marzo 21, específicamente, es el “Día del Síndrome Down.” Como muchos de ustedes sabrán mi hermana María tiene Síndrome Down. Ustedes saben bien que es muy importante para mí el crear conciencia acerca de estos asuntos. Quizás recuerden que hace cuatro años, yo participe en “salto polar” para recaudar fondos para las Olimpiadas Especiales.

Finalmente, aunque Marzo 1º es un día dedicado a cero discriminación, Marzo 21, es el “Día Internacional para la Eliminación de la Discriminación Racial.” Dios sabe que todavía tenemos mucho trabajo por hacer. Debemos despertar conciencias no solo sobre como otros discriminan, sino también sobre cómo cada uno de nosotros mismos pudiéramos aun estar atrapados por nuestros propios pensamientos o actos discriminatorios. Debemos recordar que no importa cuán diferente seamos los unos de los otros, todos y cada uno somos creaturas amadas de Dios. ¡Seamos conscientes! - **Paz, Fr. Andy**
