From the Pastor: Palm Sunday has already arrived, or finally arrived, depending on your point of view. Nonetheless, this is the beginning of Holy Week. Each day this week in our parish, or nearby, there is a special event – Seder Meal, Chrism Mass at the Cathedral, Reconciliation Service with confessions, Mass of Lord’s Supper, reading of the Lord’s Passion, Adoration of the Cross, and the Vigil of Easter with baptisms, confirmations, and first communion.

Are you ready!

For some people Holy Week does not appear to be different because they do not change their schedule. Nothing changes in their life. Holy Week is just another week and they only see Easter as a special Sunday Mass. In fact, it is every Sunday that is a “little Easter.” Easter is the center of our Christian faith. Our faith-lives revolve around Easter!

Because of the centrality of Easter we prove to be wise as we use Holy Week so as to be enriched by the great revelations of Easter. With Easter we know that death no longer has hold over us, that our sins are forgiven, that violence and vengeance have lost their power, and that our lives are eternal. Such truths require some thoughtful and prayerful consideration. The powerlessness of death, sin, violence, and vengeance, and the promise of eternal life have proven difficult for many to accept. Even Christians are seduced to think that they express power by their use of threats of death, violence, and vengeance. In fact, we believe that it is only love, forgiveness, and the freedom which comes with faith in the promise of eternal life which express true power.

Because of Easter’s importance, the traditions and images of Palm Sunday and Holy Week prepare us for the final days. We “enter into” the week, carrying the palms. We remember Jesus decision to go to Jerusalem in order to face his final challenges and his accusers. We focus on Jesus’ willingness to lovingly make an unselfish sacrifice for the sake of others, for OUR sake. His sacrifice of love manifests the power of love and forgiveness. His Resurrection is the promise to us that we will live in his love, forever. **-Peace, Fr. Andy**

Mensaje de nuestro Párroco: Ya ha llegado el Domingo de Ramos, o dependiendo de cómo lo vean, por fin llegó el Domingo de Ramos. Sin embargo, este es el comienzo de la Semana Santa. Cada día esta semana en nuestra parroquia, o en algún lugar cercano, hay algún evento especial – la Cena Pascual, Misa del Santo Crisma en la Catedral, el servicio de Reconciliación con confesiones, la Misa de la Última Cena del Señor, la lectura de la Pasión del Señor, Adoración de la Santa Cruz, y la Vigilia Pascual con bautismos, confirmaciones, y primeras comuniones.

¡Están listos!

Para algunas personas la Semana Santa no es distinta de ninguna otra porque ellos no cambian su horario. Nada cambia en su vida. Semana Santa es simplemente otra semana y ellos solamente ven la Pascua como una Misa Dominical especial. Aunque de hecho, cada domingo es una “pequeña Pascua.” La Pascua es el centro de nuestra fe Cristiana. Nuestras vidas de fe giran alrededor de la Pascua!

Debido a la crucial importancia de la Pascua, es muy sabia la forma en que aprovechamos la Semana Santa para enriquecernos con las grandes revelaciones pascuales. Por la Pascua sabemos que la muerte ya no tiene poder sobre nosotros, que nuestros pecados han sido perdonados, que la violencia y la venganza han perdido su poder, y que nuestras vidas son eternas. Dichas verdades requieren que las consideremos atenta y devotamente. La impotencia de la muerte, el pecado, la violencia, la venganza, y la promesa de la vida eterna, son algo difícil de aceptar para muchos. Aun los mismos cristianos llegan a pensar que el uso de amenazas de muerte, violencia y venganza, son expresiones de poder. Cuando de hecho nuestra fe nos dice que solamente el amor, el perdón, y la libertad, que vienen de la promesa de la vida eterna, son expresiones del poder verdadero.

Dada la importancia de la Pascua, las tradiciones e imágenes del Domingo de Ramos y Semana Santa, nos preparan para los días finales. “Entramos” a la semana, cargando palmas. Recordamos la decisión de Jesús de ir a Jerusalén para poder confrontar sus retos finales y a sus acusantes. Nos enfocamos en la disposición de Jesús de hacer un sacrificio amoroso y desinteresado por bien de otros, por NUESTRO bien. Su sacrificio de amor manifiesta el poder de amor y perdón. Su Resurrección es la promesa para nosotros de que viviremos en su amor, para siempre. - **Paz, Fr. Andy**
