From the Pastor: Week #3 – Same question: “*If our church closed tomorrow, how much time would pass before the community noticed?*”

Many people would know right away if we were to close. Two weeks ago I wrote about the outreach ministries of our parish. Last week I wrote about the people who come to our parish seeking spiritual and moral help. This week, allow me to highlight groups from outside the parish who trust that St. Willebrord Parish will assist them. These groups would know very quickly if St. Willys closed.

We have two *Alcoholic Anonymous (AA)* groups which meet on Thursdays, one for those who speak Spanish and one in English. Then another Spanish speaking group meets on Saturday morning, and another on Sunday morning. They also celebrate sobriety anniversaries. I have attended anniversaries of 10, 25, and just last weekend, 30 years of sobriety! They regularly tell me how grateful they are for giving them a safe place to meet.

The *Third Order Carmelites* use our confessionals for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the church for Adoration, Mass, and Evening Prayer, and then our Parish Center, once each month. *Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA)* holds training for their organization which recruits, screens, and trains everyday citizens to be the voices of abused and neglected children in the courtroom, seeking to ensure them safe and permanent homes. *Casa Alba Melanie*, too, sponsors community outreach and education for families, especially in the Hispanic community and often requests to use our Parish Center.

Green Bay Public Schools occasionally offers informational programming for families at St. Willys. The *Immigration and Advocacy Network* holds its monthly meetings in our Parish Center. *Casa Mexico* and *Voces de la Frontera* use our Parish Center for activities such as immigrant education, visa and passport processes, and other community education activities. The *City of Green Bay Water Utility* and the *Brown County Public Health Department* will soon hold an informational meeting about lead pipes. *Family Services* recently offered a workshop to parents and catechists on sexual abuse.

There are other groups and organizations which use our buildings for community outreach and education. While these activities are not faith or worship oriented, they address the needs of the human person. St. Willebrord Parish seeks to serve all who come to our doors with an open heart.

La semana pasada escribí acerca de las personas que vienen a nuestra parroquia buscando ayuda moral y espiritual. Esta semana, permítanme resaltar a los grupos que no son parte de la parroquia y que confían que St. Willebrord los asistirá. Si St. Willys cerrara estos grupos, se darían cuenta muy rápido.

Tenemos dos grupos de ***Alcohólicos Anónimos (AA)*** que se reúnen los Jueves, uno en español y el otro en inglés. También el grupo en español reúne los Sábados y Domingos por la mañana. Ellos también celebran sus aniversarios de sobriedad. Yo he estado en aniversarios de 10, 25, y el fin de semana pasado de 30 años de sobriedad! Ellos me dicen usualmente cuan agradecidos se sienten por proveerles un lugar seguro para realizar sus reuniones.

La ***Tercera Orden Carmelita*** usa nuestros confesionarios para el Sacramento de la Reconciliación y la iglesia para adoración, misa, y oración vespertina, y luego se reúnen en nuestro Centro Parroquial, una vez al mes. La organización (***CASA) Court Appointed Special Advocates*** lleva a cabo reuniones de entrenamiento en el Centro Parroquial. Ellos reclutan, examinan, y entrenan a ciudadanos comunes, para abogar en la corte por niños que sufren de abuso y negligencia, y les ayudan a buscar hogares seguros y permanentes. ***Casa Alba Melanie***, también ofrece servicios comunitarios y educación para familias, especialmente de la comunidad hispana y ellos frecuentemente piden acceso a nuestro Centro Parroquial.

Las ***Escuelas Públicas de Green Bay*** ocasionalmente ofrecen información para las familias en St. Willys. El grupo ***Immigration and Advocacy Network*** también lleva a cabo su reunión mensual en nuestro Centro Parroquial. ***Casa Mexico*** y ***Voces de la Frontera*** usan nuestro Centro Parroquial para actividades relacionadas a la educación de los inmigrantes, el proceso para obtener visas y pasaportes, y otras actividades educacionales. El ***Servicio Público de Agua de la Ciudad de Green Bay*** y el ***Departamento de Salud del Condado de Brown*** muy pronto llevarán a cabo una sesión informativa acerca del plomo. ***Family Services*** recientemente ofreció un taller para padres y catequistas sobre el abuso sexual.

Hay otros grupos y organizaciones que usan nuestras instalaciones para servicios a la comunidad y educación. Aunque estas actividades no se enfocan en la fe ni la alabanza, si responden a las necesidades del ser humano. La parroquia St. Willebrord trata de servir a todo el que viene a nuestras puertas con un corazón abierto.
