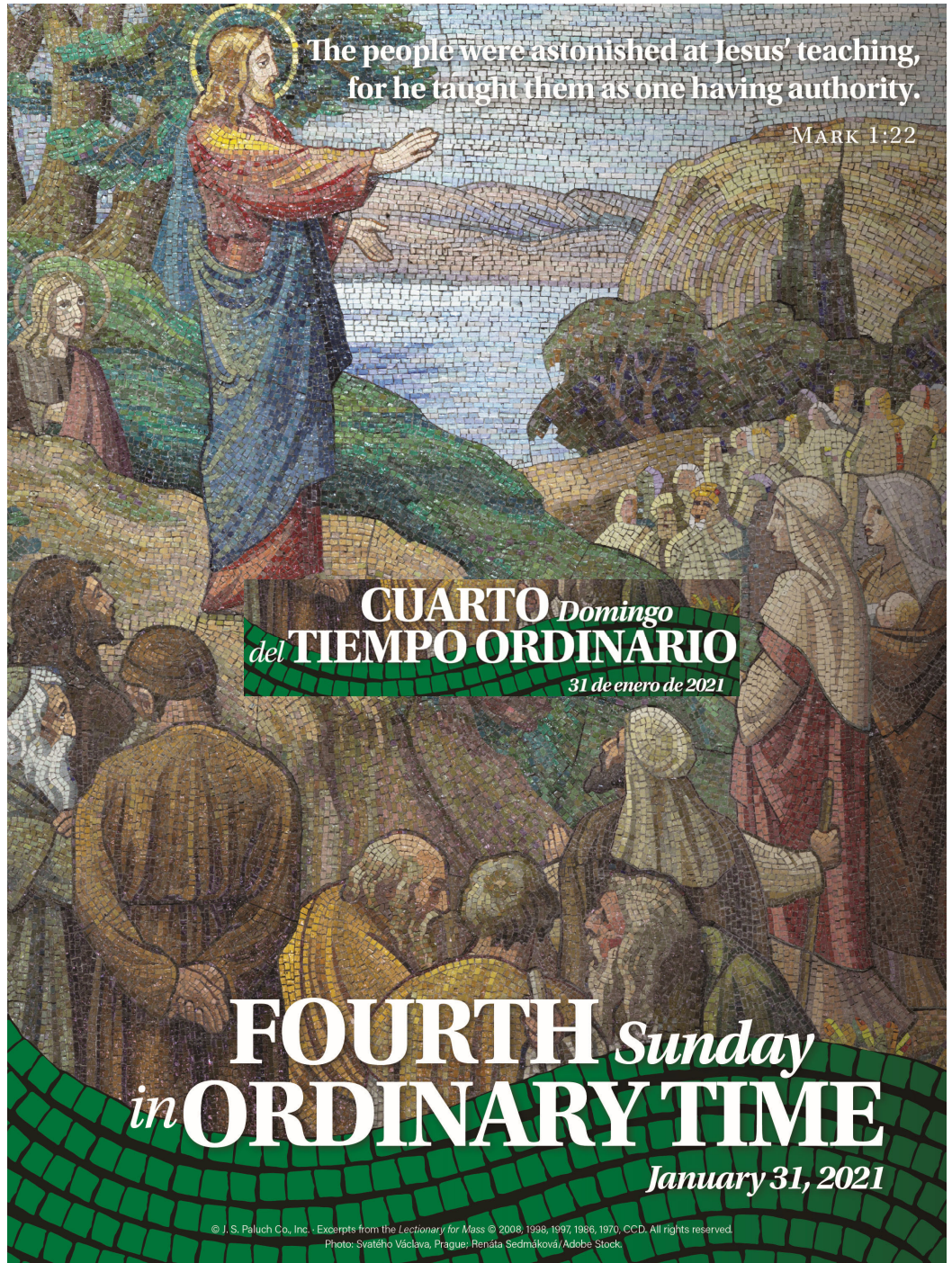

From the Pastor: The 900th anniversary of the beginning the Norbertine Order will be a theme upon which I reflect more than a few times over the next year. Remembering the founding principles, the historical context, the persons and personalities, as well as the details of Norbertine history and events over the nine centuries will all be material for articles.

As one of my activities during the jubilee year, I am going to read some of the books about St. Norbert and the history of the Order. I have read most of the books available in English, however, there is one biography that is relatively new that I have not read. *Man on Fire: The Life and Spirit of Norbert of Xanten*, by Thomas Kunkel, 2019, is the book I am currently reading. Kunkel is the former president of St. Norbert College whose professional training is in the field of journalism. He uses excellent phrasing and gives life to the story of Norbert. I have read many versions of Norbert's history and this is among the best and most readable.

If you are interested in more information about the Norbertine Order (officially known as The Order of Premontre), go to www.premontre.org. There, in the menu for "Library," you will find two 12th century biographies of St. Norbert, called *Vita A* and *Vita B*. They are two distinct but similar texts that are part history of the man and part stories of his life that are typical of the stories told of remarkable and holy people. These special stories are identified as *hagiography*. This is a word from Greek which means "writings about the holy ones." These writings are passed on not because they are factually true, but rather because it would be fitting if the events happened in the manner described, given the involvement of such a holy person. In any case the two *Vitae* are interesting to read.

St. Norbert Abbey's website (www.norbertines.org), too, may be a site to which you may want to link this year in order to stay informed about anniversary events and news. COVID-19 has already limited some of the programming, but there are various activities throughout the year. Already you might have seen the banners, one of which is displayed on the pillar in the church above the ambo, and the other in the parking lot.

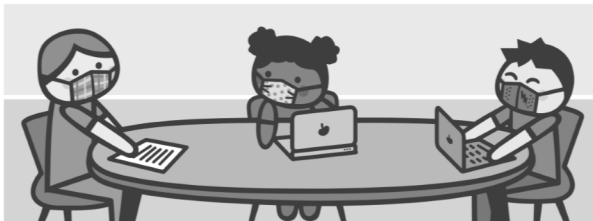

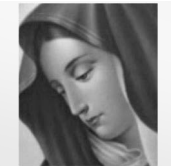

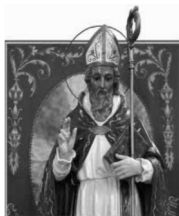


Fiesta de San Blas

Esta es una forma más antigua de la distribución de las cenizas que continúa en la Iglesia hoy en día en gran parte de Italia y proporciona una menor oportunidad de difundir COVID 19.



Mensaje de Nuestro Pastor: El 900 aniversario del comienzo de la Orden Norbertina será un tema sobre el que reflexiono más de una vez durante el próximo año. Recordar los principios fundacionales, el contexto histórico, las personas y personalidades, así como los detalles de la historia y los acontecimientos de la historia de los Norbertinos a lo largo de los nueve siglos serán material para artículos.

Una de mis actividades durante el año de nuestro aniversario, será leer algunos de los libros sobre San Norberto y la historia de la Orden Norbertina. He leído la mayoría de los libros disponibles en inglés, sin embargo, hay una biografía que es relativamente nueva que no he leído. *Man on Fire: The Life and Spirit of Norbert of Xanten*, de Thomas Kunkel, 2019 (Titulo: Hombre en Fuego: La Vida y Espíritu de Norberto de Xanten; escrito por Thomas Kunkel en 2019), es el libro que estoy leyendo actualmente. Kunkel es el ex presidente del colegio de St. Norbert cuya formación profesional se encuentra en el campo del periodismo. Utiliza expresiones excelentes y da vida a la historia de Norberto. He leído muchas versiones de la historia de Norberto y esta es una de las mejores y más legibles.

Si usted está interesado en informarse más sobre la Orden Norbertina (oficialmente conocida como La Orden de Premontre), visite la pagina de internet www.premontre.org. Allí, en el menú bajo "Biblioteca", encontrará dos biografías del siglo XII de San Norberto, llamadas *Vita A* y *Vita B*. Son dos textos distintos pero similares que son parte historia del hombre y parte historia de su vida que son típicas de las historias contadas de personas notables y santas. Estas historias especiales se identifican como hagiografía. Esta es una palabra del griego que significa "escritos sobre los santos". Estos escritos se transmiten no porque sean factualmente verdaderos, sino más bien porque sería apropiado que los acontecimientos ocurrieran de la manera descrita, dada la participación de esa persona santa. En cualquier caso, las dos *Vitae* son interesantes para leer.

La pagina de internet de la Abadía de St. Norbert (www.norbertines.org), también, puede ser un sitio al que puede visitar regularmente este año con el fin de mantenerse informado sobre eventos del aniversario y noticias. COVID-19 ya ha limitado parte de la programación, pero hay varias actividades a lo largo del año. Ya es posible que haya visto las banderas, una esta en el pilar de la iglesia sobre el ambón, y la otra esta en el estacionamiento.

Actividades, noticias y eventos que puede haber, en cualquier sentido, pedimos sus oraciones, así mismo pedimos que promuevan la vida religiosa como hermano o sacerdote Norbertino. En el futuro, haré una lista clara de todos los Norbertinos que han ayudado aquí a lo largo de los años.

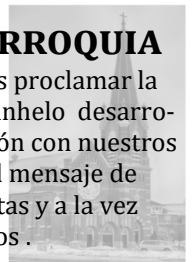

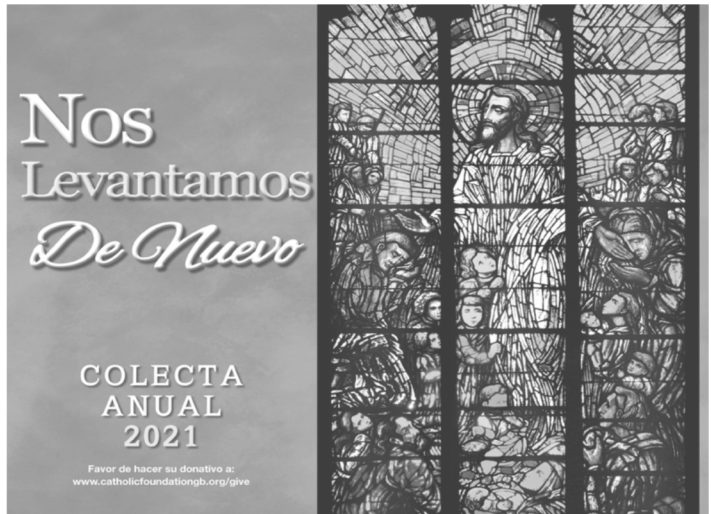


