

From the Pastor: *“Repent, and believe in the Gospel!”* There are Catholics who think church leaders do not give a fair hearing to capitalism. As one who listens to church leaders, I disagree.

In the encyclical *Centisimus Annus* (1991), no. 42, St. Pope John Paul II wrote the following about whether capitalism can be a way by which economies and societies are built up: *“If by capitalism is meant an economic system which recognizes the fundamental and positive role of business, the market, private property and the resulting responsibility for the means of production as well as [my bold] free human creativity in the economic sector, then the answer is certainly in the affirmative...But if by capitalism is meant a system in which freedom in the economic sector is not circumscribed within a strong juridical framework which places it at the service of human freedom in its totality and which sees it as a particular aspect of that freedom, the core of which is ethical and religious, then the reply is certainly negative...”*

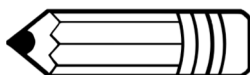
I subscribe to what St. John Paul II says in *Centisimus Annus*. He does not dismiss capitalism as evil, nor as perfect. Capitalists seeks free markets, but John Paul says they must do so with a measure of protection of the health, safety and overall well-being of the human community. Without such protections then the quest for profits can be, for example, damaging to workers, to local residents near factories, or to other stakeholders. The pope warns that capitalism must be regulated by “a strong juridical framework” which protects human freedom.

Catholic social teaching, by which we can affirm and critique economic philosophies, sees economies as serving “human freedom.” Production of useful goods and services, just wages for workers, and reasonable profits for owners are all good outcomes. Still, every business plan needs to be guided by the moral principles which serve the Common Good. The Common Good includes protection of the environment in which we live, as well as other values. Pope Francis emphasized those environmental principles in his encyclical *Laudato Si*.

For all those workers, taxpayers, entrepreneurs, and business owners who contribute to society by their efforts to produce useful goods and services, we can all be grateful. Inventors and investors have largely been a benefit to society. Still, we must keep in mind a holistic sense of the well-being of society as we measure and evaluate the results of capitalist endeavors. *Repent, and believe in the Gospel!*

As a special way to walk with our less fortunate brothers and sisters during Lent, the Social Justice Committee is collecting items for NEW Community Homeless Shelter.

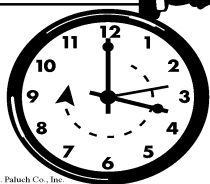

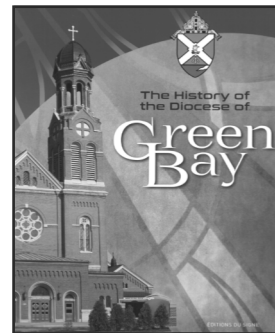

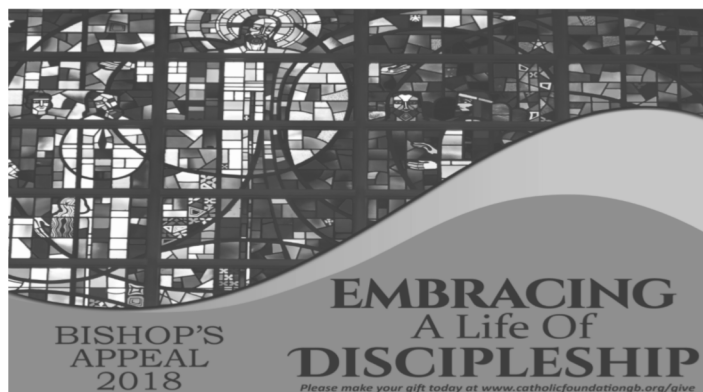

Mensaje de nuestro Párroco: ¡Arrepiéntete, y cree en el Evangelio! Hay católicos que piensan que los líderes de la iglesia no dan una audiencia justa al capitalismo. Como alguien que escucha a los líderes de la iglesia, no estoy de acuerdo.

En la encíclica *Centisimus Annus* (1991), no. 42, San Juan Pablo II escribió lo siguiente acerca de si el capitalismo puede ser una forma de construir economías y sociedades...

Centisimus Annos (1991), no. 42

Si por «capitalismo» se entiende un sistema económico que reconoce el papel fundamental y positivo de la empresa, del mercado, de la propiedad privada y de la consiguiente responsabilidad para con los medios de producción, de la libre creatividad humana [el énfasis mio] en el sector de la economía, la respuesta ciertamente es positiva... Pero si por «capitalismo» se entiende un sistema en el cual la libertad, en el ámbito económico, no está encuadrada en un sólido contexto jurídico que la ponga al servicio de la libertad humana integral y la considere como una particular dimensión de la misma, cuyo centro es ético y religioso, entonces la respuesta es absolutamente negativa..."

Me suscribo a lo que dice San Juan Pablo II en *Centisimus Annus*. Él no descarta el capitalismo como malvado, ni como perfecto. Los capitalistas buscan mercados libres, pero John Paul dice que deben hacerlo con una medida de protección de la salud, la seguridad y el bienestar general de la comunidad humana. Sin tales protecciones, la codicia de tener ganancias puede, por ejemplo, perjudicar a los trabajadores y los residentes locales que están cerca de las fábricas u otras partes en las que ellos tienen interés. El Papa advierte que el capitalismo debe estar regulado por "un marco jurídico muy fuerte" que proteja la libertad humana.

La enseñanza social católica, mediante la cual podemos afirmar y juzgar las filosofías económicas, toma en cuenta que las economías están para servir a la "libertad humana". La producción de bienes y servicios públicos, salarios justos para los trabajadores y beneficios razonables para los propietarios son buenos resultados. Aún así, cada plan de negocios debe guiarse por los principios morales que sirven al bien común. El bien común incluye la protección del ambiente en el que vivimos, así como otros valores. El Papa Francisco enfatizó esos principios ambientales en su encíclica *Laudato Si*.

Para todos aquellos trabajadores, contribuyentes, empresarios y dueños de negocios que contribuyen a la sociedad por sus esfuerzos para producir bienes y servicios útiles, todos podemos estar agradecidos. Los inventores y los inversores han sido en gran medida un beneficio para la sociedad. Aún así, debemos tener en cuenta un sentido holístico del bienestar de la sociedad a medida que medimos y evaluamos los resultados de los esfuerzos capitalistas. ¡Arrepiéntete, y cree en el Evangelio!

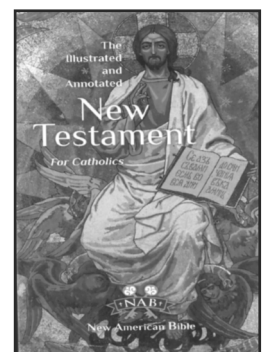

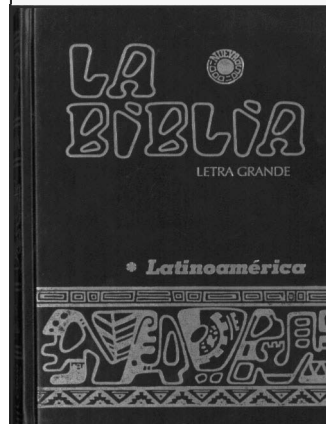

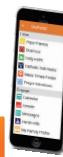
