From the Pastor: Last weekend we “sent” 17 adults and children to St. Francis Xavier Cathedral to the Rite of Election with Bp. David Ricken presiding. Fourteen (14) of them will receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil, April 3rd. Three (3) of them will be confirmed and receive First Eucharist.

These 17 men, women and children have been studying and praying for months. Our parish process began in September, but several of these candidates have been preparing for a long time in order to become Catholic. Their photos are featured in the display case near the Sacristy. Please pray for them as they complete this next phase. The two groups are now referred to as “The Elect” (the 14) and “Candidates for Full Communion in the Catholic Church” (the 3 already baptized).

Looking forward to Easter, 2022, we encourage those who want to become Catholic to inquire about the process. If you know someone who needs information about becoming Catholic, please encourage them. So many people are without an anchor of faith, without the foundation of good catechesis. As a parish community we want to help. Please call the Parish Office for more information.

In addition to the above-mentioned persons, we have more than 20 teenagers preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. This past week, many of them helped prepare a meal for about 250 people at the N.E.W. Community Shelter. We are grateful for their act of charity and service. Each month a parish group is responsible for a meal. We are grateful to those who donate to that meal and to those who prepare it.

Regarding disciplines of Lent, remember that members of the Catholic Church fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (eat only one full meal), and abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent. To choose not to follow those rules/practices is a sin against the community, against the solidarity that we are trying to foster by our communal commitment.

Personal disciplines that we fail to keep are personal failures, but these failures are not sins. For instance, if a person chooses to fast for 40 days, eating only bread and drinking water, but is unable to maintain that strict discipline, it is not a sin. Or, if a person chooses to give up meat not only on the required Fridays, but also on Wednesdays, and fails to keep that personal choice, it is not a sin. Even those who, because of poor health or advanced age, cannot fast or abstain from meat according to Church rules, does not sin because of the importance of not harming their health. Ask your Pastor or other church personnel about what is a sin, and what is a personal failure and not a sin.

“Prayer Translation”

“The only constant in life is change.” This is a quote we may all relate to very well as we continue to experience the many changes caused by the recent pandemic. Soon, there will be a new change that we will experience in the Church’s prayer at Mass.

Our Catholic Church continues to strive to make consistent and universal what she prays throughout the world. Great effort has been made to translate faithfully and accurately the various prayers of the Mass from its original source language which is Latin. About ten years ago, you might remember the many changes in translation to the Mass that took place. Now, one more small but important change has been made to the conclusion of the collect (opening prayer) at Mass.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, 2021, the word “one” will be omitted in the doxology or conclusion of the opening prayer at Mass. Thus the prayer will now read, “...in the unity of the Holy Spirit, **God**, for ever and ever.” The reason for this change is that the word “God” in this prayer refers to Jesus Christ and his divinity and not specifically to the Holy Trinity. In order to avoid confusion regarding the divinity of Christ, this change has now been made.

This was requested by Pope Francis in the Vatican and overwhelmingly approved by the Catholic bishops of our country. Like all changes, this will take a little getting used to. However, it will soon become part of the way we pray and I believe it will help to strengthen our faith.

While it is true that, when possible, receiving both species helps us to appreciate and value the fullness of the sacrifice of Christ, either the Body or the Blood of Christ is sufficient.

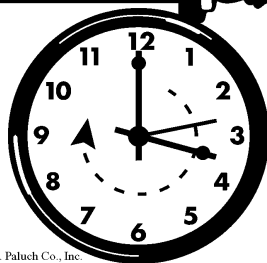

Faith Formation



As we continue to live our English Faith Formation program virtually we realize that we are nine classes away from the end of this course. Nine classes seem like a lot but it actually goes by fast especially for those who are preparing to receive a sacrament in May.

If you are thinking about registering your child for next course, please know that registrations begin in May and run through early August or earlier if we meet capacity. A few points to note that will help you determine when your child needs to begin sacrament preparation:

- First communion preparation is a 2-year program. Children who will be entering 1st grade in September 2021 need to register for Year A-First communion. If your child is older and has not received their First Communion, you can still register them in Year A-First communion and I place them in the age appropriate group.
- Confirmation is also a 2-year preparation. Per Diocesan guidelines students under the age of 17 or those not in 11th or 12th grade cannot receive Confirmation. Therefore, we ask that if your child is in 10th or 11th grade you register them into Pre-Confirmation so then they can prepare to receive their sacrament in grades 11 or 12.
- If your child has already received their First communion but is too young to enroll in Pre-Confirmation you can still enroll them in our program in one of the age/grade appropriate groups. This is a great way for them to continue to learn about their faith along with their peers.

In the meantime, keep this information in mind for when May comes around. Hopefully it will come soon and will bring sunshine and warmth.

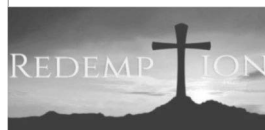

Mensaje de Nuestro Pastor: El fin de semana pasado "enviamos" a 17 adultos y niños a la Catedral de St. Francis Xavier al Rito de Elección conducido por el Obispo David Ricken. Catorce (14) de ellos recibirán los sacramentos de iniciación (bautismo, confirmación, eucaristía) en la Vigilia pascual, el 3 de Abril. Tres (3) de ellos serán confirmados y recibirán la Primera Eucaristía.

Estos 17 hombres, mujeres y niños se han estado preparando y orando durante meses. Nuestro proceso parroquial comenzó en septiembre, pero varios de estos candidatos se han estado preparando durante mucho tiempo para convertirse en católicos. Sus fotos están en la vitrina cerca de la Sacristía. Por favor, oren por ellos mientras completan esta siguiente fase. Los dos grupos ahora se conocen como "Los Elegidos" (los 14) y "Candidatos a la Comunión Plena en la Iglesia Católica" (los 3 ya bautizados).

En anticipación del día de Pascua 2022, animamos a aquellos que quieren ser católicos a preguntar sobre el proceso. Si conoce a alguien que necesita información sobre ser católico, anímelos. Muchas personas están sin un ancla de fe, sin el fundamento de una buena catequesis. Como comunidad parroquial queremos ayudar. Llame a la Oficina Parroquial para obtener más información.

Además de las personas antes mencionadas, tenemos más de 20 adolescentes preparándose para recibir el sacramento de la confirmación. La semana pasada, muchos de ellos ayudaron a preparar una comida para más o menos 250 personas en el Refugio Comunitario del Noreste de Wisconsin. Estamos agradecidos por su acto de caridad y servicio. Cada mes un grupo parroquial se encarga de preparar esta comida. Estamos agradecidos a aquellos que donan para comprar la comida y a quienes la preparan dando su tiempo.

En cuanto a las disciplinas de cuaresma, recuerde que los miembros de la Iglesia Católica ayunan el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo (comen sólo una comida completa), y se abstienen de la carne todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma. Optar por no seguir esas reglas/prácticas es un pecado contra la comunidad, contra la solidaridad que estamos tratando de fomentar por nuestro compromiso comunal.

Las disciplinas personales que no guardamos son fracasos personales, pero estos fracasos no son pecados. Por ejemplo, si una persona decide ayunar durante 40 días, comiendo sólo pan y agua potable, pero es incapaz de mantener esa estricta disciplina, no es un pecado. O, si una persona decide renunciar a la carne no sólo los viernes requeridos, sino también los miércoles, y no mantiene esa elección personal, no es un pecado. Incluso aquellos que, debido a su mala salud o edad avanzada, no pueden ayunar o abstenerse de la carne de acuerdo con las reglas de la Iglesia, no pecan debido a la importancia de no dañar su salud. Pregúntele a su párroco u otro personal de la iglesia acerca de lo que es un pecado, y lo que es un fracaso personal y no un pecado.

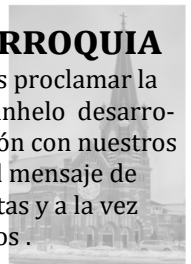

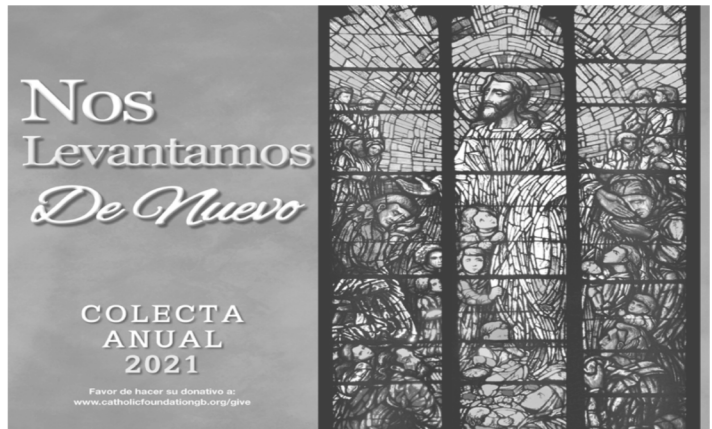

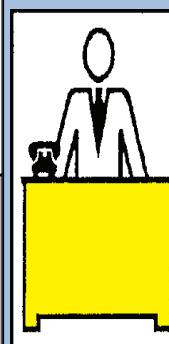
