From the Pastor: The concerns with the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) which threatens the health of people throughout the world has made me think more of people who are living with chronic and enduring illnesses. I invite everyone to pray for and pay attention to those people who face illness and disability EVERY DAY! for a long time.

Our loved ones and friends who have chronic diseases or disabilities must live with an awareness about their health about which many of us do not think. People with diabetes must monitor their sugar levels all the time, sometimes needing injections of insulin. People who have had kidney or other organ transplants must always be concerned that the body accepts the new tissue. Of course, those who await kidney transplants must use dialysis 3-4 times per week and thus endure great sacrifice and pain. Finally, I need to mention all those people who have had knee and hip replacements. The recovery is rarely easy and they never forget that the new joint is not their original one.

Then there are those who live with mental illnesses. It seems that almost once each day I learn of another person who is living with depression, or bi-polar disorder, or schizophrenia, or other serious mental illnesses. For some of these persons we must also be aware that they may be very attached to their medications. At the worst, those with mental illness attempt to self-medicate through alcohol, illicit drugs, or through prescription drugs obtained in illegal ways. The mental illness drives the desire for relief, but the so-called "relief" may be a problem in itself, with its own trials and pains.

Alcoholics, drug addicts, and those addicted to gambling or pornography demonstrate another aspect of those who are physically or psychologically impaired. The addicted persons are always oriented toward their next "fix," the next time they can be stimulated by their drug or activity of addiction. As difficult as it may be to live with and/or love someone with an addiction, we believe that God does not abandon them. In fact, addicts who are recovering teach us that God is the God of 1000 chances! A sincere desire to face and overcome one's addictions, along with a genuine longing to reconcile with those whom they have hurt, becomes the best possible medication for healing.

As we pray for those inflicted with the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), let us remember those who are chronically ill, addicted, and for those suffering in unknown ways.

Mensaje de Nuestro Pastor: La preocupación por el nuevo coronavirus (COVID-19) que amenaza la salud de las personas en todo el mundo me ha hecho pensar más en las personas que viven con enfermedades crónicas y duraderas. ¡Invito a todos a orar y prestar atención a aquellas personas que enfrentan enfermedades y discapacidades CADA DÍA! por mucho tiempo.

Nuestros seres queridos y amigos que tienen enfermedades o discapacidades crónicas deben vivir con una conciencia sobre su salud sobre lo que muchos de nosotros no pensamos. Las personas con diabetes deben controlar sus niveles de azúcar todo el tiempo, a veces necesitan inyecciones de insulina. Las personas que han recibido trasplantes de riñón u otro órgano siempre deben preocuparse de que el cuerpo acepte el nuevo tejido. Por supuesto, aquellos que esperan trasplantes de riñón deben usar diálisis de 3 a 4 veces por semana y así soportar un gran sacrificio y dolor. Finalmente, necesito mencionar a todas aquellas personas que han tenido reemplazos de rodilla y cadera. La recuperación rara vez es fácil y nunca olvidan que lo reemplazado no es el original.

Luego están los que viven con enfermedades mentales. Parece que casi una vez al día me entero de otra persona que vive con depresión, trastorno bipolar, esquizofrenia u otras enfermedades mentales graves. Para algunas de estas personas también debemos ser conscientes de que pueden estar muy apegadas a sus medicamentos. En el peor de los casos, las personas con enfermedades mentales intentan auto-medicarse con alcohol, drogas ilícitas o con medicamentos recetados obtenidos de manera ilegal. La enfermedad mental impulsa el deseo de alivio, pero el llamado "alivio" puede ser un problema en sí mismo, con sus propias pruebas y dolores.

Los alcohólicos, los drogadictos y los adictos al juego o la pornografía demuestran otro aspecto de las personas con discapacidad física o psicológica. Las personas adictas siempre están orientadas hacia su próxima "solución", la próxima vez que puedan ser estimuladas por su droga o actividad de adicción. Por difícil que sea vivir y/o amar a alguien con una adicción, creemos que Dios no los abandona. De hecho, ¡los adictos que se están recuperando nos enseñan que Dios es el Dios de las 1000 oportunidades! Un deseo sincero de enfrentar y superar las adicciones, junto con un anhelo genuino de reconciliarse con quienes han herido, se convierte en el mejor medicamento posible para la curación.

Mientras oramos por los infligidos con el Nuevo Coronavirus (COVID-19), recordemos a los que padecen enfermedades crónicas, a los adictos y a los que sufren de formas desconocidas.
