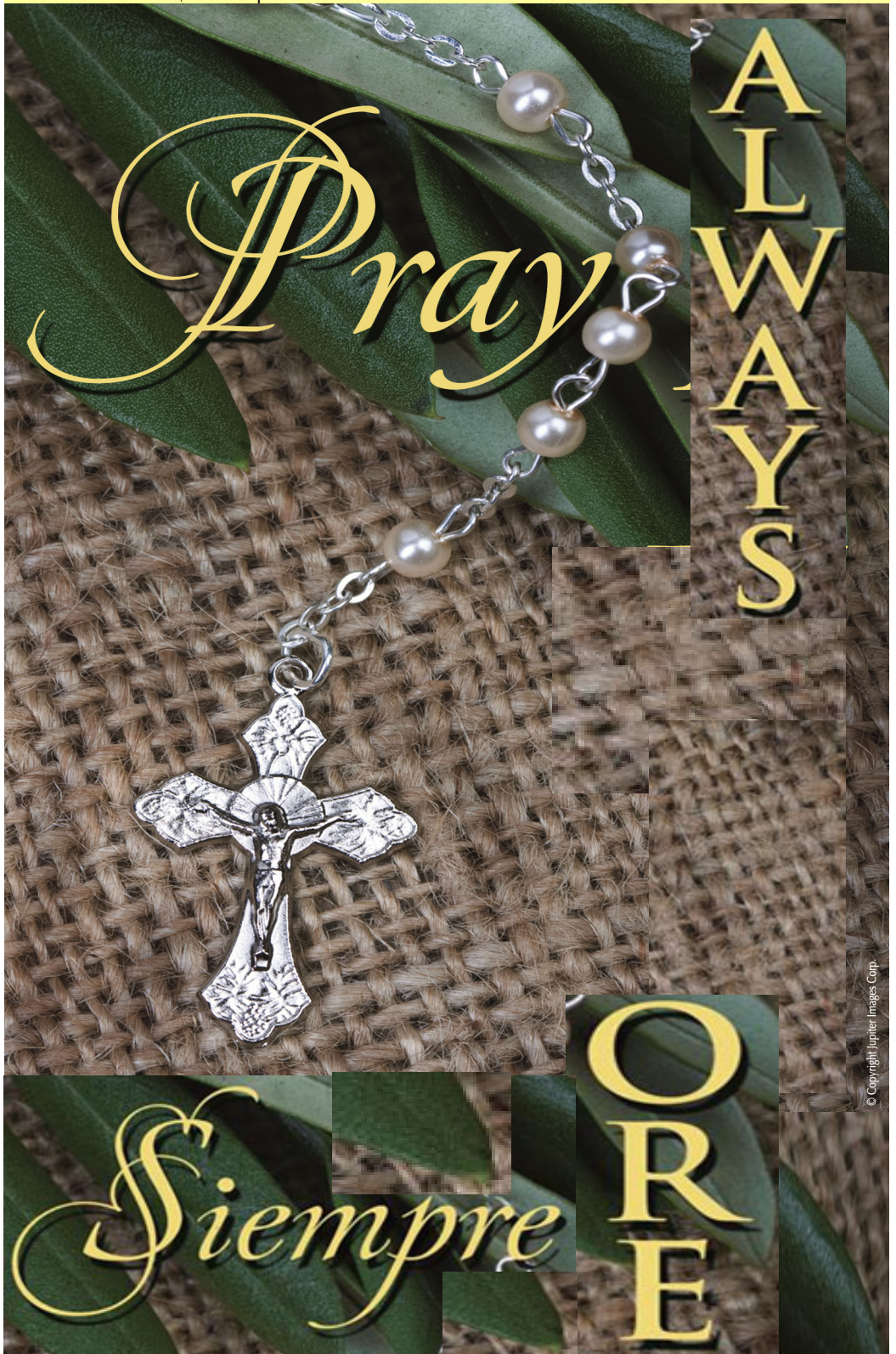

From the Pastor: My travels in Spain and Germany were very fruitful. I learned much Norbertine history, saw remarkable works of art and architecture, and met very nice people.

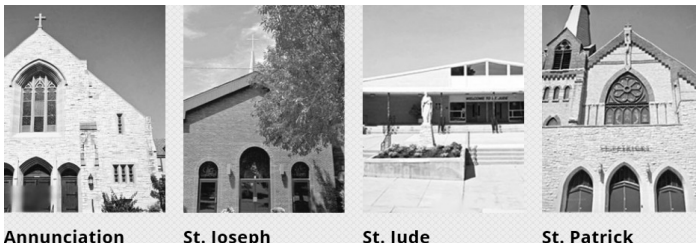
Among the people I met were the sisters of Santa Sofia Convent. These Norbertine sisters form the only remaining Norbertine community in Spain. At one time there were 47 abbeys and houses of Norbertine priests, brothers, or sisters. Spain's difficult history in which the church and religious communities suffered greatly resulted in the suppression of the houses of most Norbertines.

The sisters at the convent in Toro, Spain, with whom I spent about 4 days, are a very happy and welcoming community. They are cloistered. This means that they have little contact with the outside world. Their life is dedicated to the ministries of prayer and simple communal living. Currently, there are only 20 sisters. They are praying for vocations.

Despite being cloistered, for good reason they receive guests at the convent. When I arrived, the Abbot General of our Order had just arrived as well. So, the sisters all gathered in their workshop where they sew clothing as a means to support their community. We had a short time to ask and answer questions and for the Abbot General to give a brief report about activities in the Order. He does not speak Spanish, but does speak English. Br. Terry Lauerman and I translated for him and the sisters. I assured the sisters that I had informed St. Willebrord Parish about the important anniversary that the sisters were about to celebrate – 700 years in their convent! This anniversary is remarkable because despite all of the suppressions of religious communities, the sisters never suffered that fate. They owe that to the grace of God, and to the love of the people who protected them and spoke favorably on their behalf.

On Friday evening, September 16 they celebrated their anniversary with Mass at which the local bishop presided. There were 3 bishops, 26 priests, 1 brother, the sisters themselves, and hundreds of local townspeople who came to pray with them. People stood in the streets because the church was so full. After the Mass the people enjoyed snacks and beverages in the courtyard of the convent. Local dancers entertained the people singing and dancing in colorful traditional clothing. The people clearly expressed their love for “the Sofias,” as they call them.

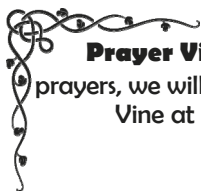

**St. Willebrord Parish Preparation Information
for the Sacrament of Confirmation for High School
Students**

In the Diocese of Green Bay, the immediate preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation traditionally begins after the sophomore year of high school. The decision to participate in the Confirmation program and celebration is an important decision made by the young person and his/her parents/guardians.

Regardless as to where the teen is schooled, the parents/guardians present the teen to the parish and in collaboration with the St. Willebrord Parish pastoral staff, commit to the preparation responsibilities.

Parents/guardians, sponsors, the pastoral staff, and catechists work together to assist and support the process of initiation before, during, and after the preparation period.

Confirmation classes for eligible juniors/seniors are already underway here at St. Willebrord, please contact Susan at ext 112 as soon as possible with any questions or concerns. Thank you!

**At Home Activities for
Catholic Households of Faith**



Back in Jesus' day, widows had little status. In today's gospel parable, one such woman comes before a judge, seeking the few rights due her. The immoral judge ignores her, but she pleads until he finally decides in her favor. He helps, not because he is good, but because she is persistent. Jesus concludes that if a corrupt judge can do justice to someone who keeps asking, God, the most loving, fair, just judge of all, will certainly listen to those who persist in prayer.

As adult role models, we are called to teach and model persistent prayer with the young people in our lives. At the same time, however, we need to help children understand the difference between whims and requirements...wants versus needs.

Prayer and other religious rituals are not magic nor points to be tallied and rewarded. Our goal is to teach the value of a healthy sense of persistence and perseverance, especially when seeking justice. The widow's request was not for privilege but for justice.

In his encyclical, *On the Development of Peoples*, Pope Paul VI urged all Catholics and all people of the world to work for both justice and peace. How can you and your household of faith both work and pray for justice and peace in our time?

Check this book out from the children's library and read it with the young people in your life: *Ruby's Wish* by Shirin Yim Bridges. Ruby wants to go to the university but in her country, in her time, this was not possible for girls. With help from her grandfather, Ruby's perseverance and dedication leads to change – a change to new ways based on justice. (Chronicle Books, 2002)



Mensaje de Nuestro Párroco: Mi viaje a España y Alemania fue muy productivo. Aprendí mucho sobre la historia Norbertina, vi impresionantes obras de arte y arquitectura, y me encontré con gente muy agradable. Entre las personas que conocí estaban las hermanas del Convento de Santa Sofía. Estas hermanas Norbertinas forman la comunidad Norbertina que queda en España. En un tiempo había 47 abadías y casas de sacerdotes Norbertinos, hermanos o hermanas. Las dificultades en la historia de España con la iglesia y las comunidades religiosas han hecho que las comunidades sufran en gran magnitud y como resultado la mayoría de casas de los Norbertinos han sido forzosamente cerradas.

Las religiosas en el convento que está en Toro, España, con las cuales pase 4 días, están muy contentas y le dan la bienvenida a la comunidad. Ellas están recluidas. Esto quiere decir que ellas tienen muy poco contacto con el mundo fuera del convento. Ellas dedican su vida al ministerio de oración y a vivir una vida sencilla en comunidad. Presentemente, ellas tienen 20 hermanas religiosas en el convento. Ellas están rezando para más vocaciones.

Aunque ellas están recluidas, reciben invitados en el convento por muy buenas razones. Cuando llegué, el Abad General de la Orden acababa de llegar también. Por lo tanto, las hermanas se reunieron en su taller donde cosen prendas de vestir como un medio de recaudar fondos para su comunidad. Tuvimos poco tiempo para preguntar y responder preguntas, y para que el Abad General nos diera un breve informe sobre las actividades de la Orden. Él no habla español, pero sí habla Inglés. Br. Terry Lauerman y yo traduje para él y las hermanas también. Les aseguré a las hermanas que les había informado a todos en la Parroquia de San Willebrord sobre el aniversario importante que las hermanas estaban a punto de cumplir, 700 años - en su convento! Este aniversario es sumamente importante porque a pesar de todas las dificultades por las que han pasado las comunidades religiosas, las hermanas no sufrieron el mismo destino. Se lo deben a la gracia de Dios, y el amor de las personas que las protegían y hablaron favorablemente en su nombre.

La noche del viernes 16 de septiembre se celebra su aniversario con una misa que es oficiada por el obispo local. Hubo 3 obispos, 26 sacerdotes, 1 hermano, las hermanas, y cientos de vecinos del lugar que vinieron a orar con ellas. La gente se tuvo que parar afuera en las calles porque la iglesia estaba muy llena. Después de la misa las personas pudieron disfrutar de botanas y bebidas en el patio del convento. Bailarines locales entretuvieron a la gente cantando y bailando vistiendo su ropa tradicional colorida. Las personas expresaron claramente su amor por "las Sofías," como ellos cariñosamente les llaman.
