Message from Fr. Andy: *Happy Easter!*

The death of Pope Francis has provoked many memories of his special leadership of the Catholic Church since 2013. He was well-known for his willingness to get close to the poor, the migrant, the person experiencing homelessness, the imprisoned, and he let the children come close to him even at unscripted moments during public events. He welcomed the stranger and those who had been judged harshly and even condemned. He called out ministers, both clerics and lay persons, to live simply and to try to form a "poor church for the poor." He made major moves to reform Vatican finances despite resistance from those cardinals and others who had been working there for a long time. Pope Francis had audits done. He centralized funds that had been held by various commissions and organizations within the Vatican in order to provide better oversight. He did not finish these reforms. The next pope will have some positive reform momentum with which to work.

He was known to suggest many reforms and he executed several. Some thought poorly of him as a "liberal" because he did not judge or condemn people despite some morally questionable behaviors and decisions. Francis was a man of mercy who sought to demonstrate how God is merciful. God is a judge, not us. Human beings are not the final judge, not even a Pope!

The mercy and compassion he showed and invited others to show to each other was not questioned by those who were recipients of such mercy. Rather, Pope Francis was questioned by those whom he challenged to be more simple, to be more open, to be more compassionate, to be less greedy, to be less separated from the people. He removed some powerful men from their duties, diminished their pay, and removed some of their privileges, etc. Who do you think became his biggest critics? Cardinals, bishops, priests and their associates who had lived with privilege were told to detach themselves from worldly attachments.

Pope Francis preached the Gospel in a way that I myself learned as an important preaching principle: *"Preach the Gospel in order to comfort the disturbed and disturb the comfortable."* The Good News of Jesus Christ is the saving word of God. It saves not by maintaining the status quo, but by responding to the overflowing Spirit of the Gospel. The Spirit flows to the edges, therefore, that is the place to which we must go.

"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, *"Receive the Holy Spirit..."* (John 20:21-22)

Mensaje del P.Andy: ¡Felices Pascuas!

La muerte del Papa Francisco ha provocado muchos recuerdos de su liderazgo especial de la Iglesia Católica desde 2013. Era bien conocido por su disposición a acercarse a los pobres, a los migrantes, a las personas sin hogar, a los encarcelados, y dejaba que los niños se acercaran a él incluso en momentos espontáneos durante eventos públicos. Dio la bienvenida al forastero y a los que habían sido juzgados con dureza e incluso condenados. Llamó a los ministros, tanto clérigos como laicos, a vivir con sencillez y a tratar de formar una "iglesia pobre para los pobres". Hizo movimientos importantes para reformar las finanzas del Vaticano a pesar de la resistencia de esos cardenales y otros que habían estado trabajando allí durante mucho tiempo. El papa Francisco mandó a hacer auditorías. Centralizó los fondos que habían sido retenidos por varias comisiones y organizaciones dentro del Vaticano con el fin de proporcionar una mejor supervisión. No terminó estas reformas. El próximo Papa tendrá un impulso reformista positivo con el que trabajar.

Era conocido por sugerir muchas reformas y ejecutó algunas. Algunos pensaban mal de él como un "liberal" porque no juzgaba ni condenaba a las personas a pesar de algunos comportamientos y decisiones moralmente cuestionables. Francisco fue un hombre de misericordia que buscó demostrar cómo Dios es misericordioso. Dios es un juez, no nosotros. Los seres humanos no somos el juez final, ¡ni siquiera un Papa!

La misericordia y la compasión que mostró e invitó a otros a mostrarse mutuamente no fueron cuestionadas por aquellos que eran receptores de tal misericordia. Más bien, el Papa Francisco fue cuestionado por aquellos a quienes desafió a ser más sencillos, a ser más abiertos, a ser más compasivos, a ser menos codiciosos, a estar menos separados de la gente. Destituyó a algunos hombres poderosos de sus deberes, disminuyó su salario, quitó varios de sus privilegios. ¿Quiénes crees que se convirtieron en sus mayores críticos? A los cardenales, obispos, sacerdotes y sus asociados que habían vivido con privilegios se les dijo que se desprendieran de los apegos mundanos.

El Papa Francisco predicó el Evangelio de una manera que yo mismo aprendí como un principio de predicación importante: *"Predica el Evangelio para consolar a los perturbados y perturbar a los cómodos"*. Las Buenas Nuevas de Jesucristo son la palabra salvadora de Dios. No salva manteniendo el statu quo, sino respondiendo al Espíritu desbordante del Evangelio. El Espíritu fluye hacia los bordes, por lo tanto, ese es el lugar al que debemos ir.

"La paz esté con ustedes. Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también los envío yo". Después de decir esto, sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: "Reciban el Espíritu Santo..."

PASOS PARA PREVENIR EL ABUSO

- Habla con tus hijos: Mantén una comunicación abierta para que se sientan seguros de contarte si algo les molesta.
- Educa y educa: Aprende a identificar, prevenir y reportar el abuso. Infórmate sobre entrenamientos de ambiente seguro en tu parroquia.
- Reconoce señales de advertencia: Abusadores pueden usar regalos, secretos, o actividades inapropiadas para acercarse a menores.
- Informa y actúa: Reporta cualquier sospecha de abuso a las autoridades locales o al coordinador diocesano de asistencia a víctimas.

EFFECTOS DEL ABUSO

Cuando un niño es abusado, los efectos son graves y pueden durar toda la vida. Algunos de los efectos más comunes del abuso incluyen:

- Pérdida de fe y confianza en Dios.
- Trastorno de estrés posttraumático, angustia psicológica y otros signos indirectos de trauma, como ansiedad, problemas para dormir, dolores de estómago crónicos y dolores de cabeza.
- Mayor riesgo de desarrollar problemas de conducta, abuso de sustancias y suicidio.

El sentimiento de violación llega profundamente a la psique de una persona, y los sentimientos de ira, vergüenza, dolor y traición pueden persistir mucho tiempo después del abuso.

STEPS TO PREVENT ABUSE

- Talk to your children: Keep open communication so they feel safe telling you if something bothers them.
- Educate yourself and them: Learn how to identify, prevent, and report abuse. Ask your parish about safe environment training.
- Recognize warning signs: Abusers may use gifts, secrets, or inappropriate activities to get close to minors.
- Report and act: Report any suspected abuse to local authorities or your diocesan victim assistance coordinator.

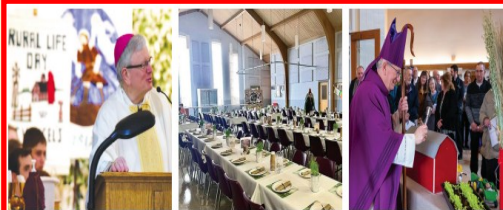
THE EFFECTS OF ABUSE

When a child is abused, the effects are serious and can last a lifetime. Some of the most common effects of abuse include:

- Loss of faith and trust in God.
- Post-traumatic stress disorder, psychological distress, and other indirect signs of trauma such as anxiety, trouble sleeping, chronic stomach pain, and headaches.
- A higher risk of developing behavioral problems, substance abuse, and suicide.

The feeling of violation runs deep into a person's psyche, and feelings of anger, shame, pain, and betrayal can persist long after the abuse has occurred.

Fr. Mark was born and raised outside of Luxemburg, WI. While attending UW-Madison studying Secondary Education-Social Studies, he felt called to priesthood. Upon graduation, he entered seminary formation and spent two years studying at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee and four years at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, Italy. He was ordained on July 1, 2017, and assigned to St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Manitowoc as well as chaplain at Roncalli High School. After one year, he was assigned as Vocation Director, which remains his primary assignment. In addition, he is also the Chaplain for St. Mary Catholic High School in Neenah, Master of Ceremonies for Confirmations with Bishop Ricken, and Chaplain to the Green Bay Packers.
