Message from Fr. Andy : The calendar of the Catholic Church has long dedicated the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. That symbol points us to the deep love of God for us, through the heart of Jesus. It is a love that we need, that we receive, and that we must share.

On the secular calendars of the world, the month of June is "Pride Month," a time in which we are invited to celebrate our sexuality, or a key way by which we express love to one another and to ourself. It seems to me that we can find connections between these different reasons for which we focus our attention and honor.

The Church must do her ministry of proclaiming the nearness, the coming, of the Kingdom of God by preaching and teaching the Gospel. The People of God, which is the Church, must be unwavering in preaching and living by Jesus's commandment to love one another as he himself loves us. Love of God, self and neighbor is the way by which we fulfill that commandment.

Jesus does not command us only to love a certain kind of people, or only to love people that look, sound, believe, and act, etc. "like us." He has given us a commandment to love everyone. But, because of narrowmindedness, prejudice, hatefulness, and sinfulness, many people have adopted a narrow group of people whom they love. Others are considered *beyond* their love. For some people, those who celebrate Pride Month, specifically, those who identify with the LGBTQ+ community, are *beyond* their love. This is not what Christ taught.

Our concerns with the practices, the culture, and the morality of particular persons is not the essence of Jesus commandment. He said: "Love one another as I have loved you." He loved by forgiving and not condemning. He loved by inviting others to come to him, and even inviting himself to enter into the homes and lives of others.

Celebrating the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the love of God, and celebrating Pride Month, will require us to love well and love abundantly, in Christ-like ways. Such celebration must move away from condemnation to new understanding and new loving relationships which fulfill Jesus's commandment.

In the Gospel of Mark 10:17-22 we read of the encounter of Jesus with the rich man who desires eternal life. Jesus, "looking at him, loved him and said, 'You are lacking one thing...'" (v. 21). Jesus looks at us today and loves us, and is prepared to help us to discover the next thing we must admit that we are lacking. For many of us it is the need to love as Jesus loved.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, Hear us we pray! Peace, Fr. Andy

Mensaje del P. Andy: El calendario de la Iglesia Católica ha dedicado durante mucho tiempo el mes de junio al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. Esta imagen nos señala el profundo amor de Dios por nosotros, a través del corazón de Jesús. Es un amor que necesitamos, que recibimos y que debemos compartir.

En los calendarios seculares del mundo, el mes de junio es el "Mes del Orgullo" (Pride Month), un momento en el que se nos invita a celebrar nuestra sexualidad, o una forma clave en la que expresamos amor a los demás y a nosotros mismos. Me parece que podemos encontrar conexiones entre estas diferentes razones por las que enfocamos nuestra atención y honor.

La Iglesia debe hacer su ministerio de anunciar la cercanía, la venida del Reino de Dios, predicando y enseñando el Evangelio. El Pueblo de Dios, que es la Iglesia, debe ser inquebrantable en la predicación y vivir según el mandamiento de Jesús de amarnos los unos a los otros como Él mismo nos ama. El amor a Dios, a uno mismo y al prójimo es la forma en que cumplimos ese mandamiento.

Jesús no nos ordena amar solo a cierto tipo de personas, o solo amar a las personas que se ven, suenan, creen y actúan, etc., "como nosotros". Él nos ha dado el mandamiento de amar a todos. Pero, debido a la estrechez de miras, los prejuicios, el odio y la pecaminosidad, muchas personas han adoptado a un grupo estrecho de personas a las que aman. Otros son considerados *más allá* de su amor. Para algunas personas, quienes celebran el Mes del Orgullo, específicamente, quienes se identifican con la comunidad LGBTQ+, están *más allá* de su amor. Esto no es lo que Cristo enseñó.

Nuestra preocupación por las prácticas, la cultura y la moralidad de personas particulares no es la esencia del mandamiento de Jesús. Él dijo: "Amados los unos a los otros como yo os he amado". Amó perdonando y no condenando. Amaba invitando a otros a venir a él, e incluso invitándose a sí mismo a entrar en los hogares y en la vida de los demás.

Celebrar el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y el amor de Dios, y celebrar el Mes del Orgullo, requerirá que amemos bien y amemos abundantemente, de manera semejante a Cristo. Tal celebración debe alejarse de la condenación y pasar a una nueva comprensión y a nuevas relaciones amorosas que cumplan el mandamiento de Jesús.

En el Evangelio de Marcos 10,17-22 leemos el encuentro de Jesús con el hombre rico que desea la vida eterna. Jesús, "mirándole, le amó y le dijo: Una cosa te falta..." (vers. 21). Jesús nos mira hoy y nos ama, y está dispuesto a ayudarnos a descubrir, lo siguiente que debemos admitir que nos falta. Para muchos de nosotros es la necesidad de amar como Jesús amó.
