Message from Fr. Andy: Having celebrated Mass on a two-story houseboat on the Napo River of Peru, I understand that the beauty and dignity of the Mass is not about location. On another trip, I celebrated Mass in the darkness of night, with one candle which emitted just enough light at the riverside jungle house on stilts where about 40 people had come to pray. I understand that location is secondary to the dignity of the people gathered at Mass and the purpose of the Sacrament we celebrate. The purpose of this second trip was to attend a meeting about the oil companies who were exploiting the land of the indigenous people of that area.

We are near to the day when we will return to our beloved and historic location in our parish church. After 20 months of celebrating, praying, grieving, singing, praising, and blessing, etc., in our Parish Center Hall, we will once again rejoice that we will be able to pray in our parish home! St. Willebrord Church was built in 1891. Much of what was constructed more than 130 years ago remains as it was – strong, beautiful, prayerful! And after the repairs and refinements, it is once again a beautiful, dignified, and SAFE place to worship.

Throughout the 20 months of repair work, we have remained a dignified, holy, prayerful, and trusting people even as we have been out of our beautiful church. You see, we are a parish family, a community of faith, a worshipping community which exists whether we have a “normal place” to worship or not.

As you see above, people have worshipped in many locations with diverse surroundings. I am sure that Fr. Jack MacCarthy can tell you of his many experiences of celebrating Mass as he served in the Peruvian mission for more than 30 years. He and I can both assure you that those communities of faith near the Napo River of Peru, despite not having churches or chapels, were able to praise and worship God with great joy. St. Willebrord Parish can attest to our perseverance and dignity as a community of faith in spite of recent, less-than-ideal conditions over these last 20 months.

We are abundantly grateful for the work of those who repaired plaster, painted and gilded the ceiling and arches, refinished and repaired pews, repaired the floor, painted and cleaned the Stations of the Cross, cleaned and replaced lighting, replaced fans, replaced the shingles of the outer roof, repaired the downspouts, replaced parking lot signs, repaired the roof at the Adams Street entrance, repaired and painted the ceiling of that entrance, and for the planning and coordination of the many details.

As you are able, come to the procession, Mass, and celebration we have planned for Friday, June 28th at 5:30 p.m. Our hearts and doors are open! **Peace, Fr. Andy**

Mensaje del P. Andy: Después de haber celebrado la Misa en una casa flotante de dos pisos en el río Napo de Perú, entiendo que la belleza y la dignidad de la Misa no tienen que ver con el lugar. En otro viaje, celebré la misa en la oscuridad de la noche, con una vela que emitía la luz suficiente en la casa sobre pilotes junto al río en la selva donde unas 40 personas habían venido a rezar. Entiendo que la ubicación es secundaria a la dignidad de las personas reunidas en la Misa y al propósito del Sacramento que celebramos. El propósito de este segundo viaje era asistir a una reunión sobre las compañías petroleras que se aprovechaban de las tierras de los indígenas de esa zona.

Estamos cerca del día en que regresaremos a nuestra querida e histórica ubicación en nuestra iglesia parroquial. Después de 20 meses de celebrar, orar, lamentar, cantar, alabar, bendecir, etc., en nuestro Salón del Centro Parroquial, ¡una vez más nos regocijaremos de poder orar en nuestra casa parroquial! La iglesia de Sn. Willebrord fue construida en 1891. Mucho de lo que se construyó hace más de 130 años permanece como era: ¡fuerte, hermoso, lleno de oración! Y después de las reparaciones y refinamientos, es una vez más un lugar hermoso, digno y SEGURO para adorar.

A lo largo de los 20 meses de trabajo de reparación, hemos seguido siendo un pueblo digno, santo, devoto y confiado, incluso cuando hemos estado fuera de nuestra hermosa iglesia. Somos una familia parroquial, una comunidad de fe, una comunidad de adoración que existe ya sea que tengamos un "lugar normal" para adorar o no.

Como puedes ver arriba, la gente ha adorado en muchos lugares con diversos entornos. Estoy seguro de que el P. Jack MacCarthy puede contarles sus muchas experiencias de celebración de la Misa mientras servía en la misión Peruana durante más de 30 años. Tanto él como yo podemos asegurarles que aquellas comunidades de fe cercanas al río Napo del Perú, a pesar de no tener iglesias ni capillas, pudieron alabar y adorar a Dios con gran alegría. La Parroquia de Sn. Willebrord puede dar fe de nuestra perseverancia y dignidad como comunidad de fe a pesar de las condiciones recientes y menos que ideales durante estos últimos 20 meses.

Estamos muy agradecidos por el trabajo de aquellos que repararon el yeso, pintaron y doraron el techo y los arcos, restauraron y repararon las bancas, repararon el piso, pintaron y limpiaron las Estaciones del Vía Crucis, limpiaron y reemplazaron la iluminación, reemplazaron los ventiladores, reemplazaron las tejas del techo exterior, repararon los bajantes, reemplazaron los letreros de los estacionamientos, repararon el techo en la entrada de la calle Adams, repararon y pintaron el techo de esa entrada, y para la planificación y coordinación de los muchos detalles.

Como puedas, ven a la procesión, misa y celebración que hemos planeado para el viernes 28 de junio a las 5:30 p.m. ¡Nuestros corazones y puertas están abiertos! **Paz, P. Andy**
