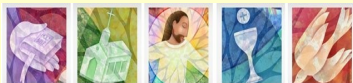

The preparation for Confirmation starts when a teen is in 10th grade.

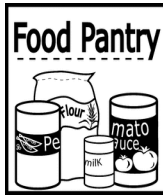

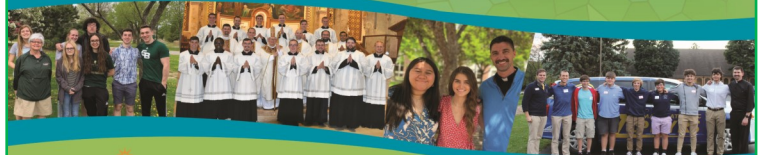

Message from Fr. Andy: The new school year will begin soon: August 29th for GRACE Catholic schools, and September 5th for Green Bay Public Schools. Students, administrators, teachers and staff are all beginning to think about the new year. Each of these groups has their own role – to learn, to organize, to teach, and to keep order and cleanliness. We pray that each may fulfill their role with success and with great respect for the roles of the others.

Every experience and encounter is an opportunity for learning. Children learning how to walk to and from school and/or to ride buses or share rides with other families is a learning opportunity. Everyone involved will have a chance to coordinate schedules, to share spaces in cars and buses, to obey crossing guards, to watch out for each other's safety, to deal with different kinds of weather, and to be kind to and patient with each other as many people arrive at school together around the same time, etc. All of these moments can be important moments of learning, even as important as math, reading, writing, history, and language arts. Parents, bus drivers, car pool drivers, teachers, security personnel and many others will be learning at the same time that the students learn. As these adults learn, they are teaching the young girls and boys how to learn from daily living.

Learning how to be a respectful young person requires that adults be good examples. The book entitled, *All I Need to Know I Learned in Kindergarten*, by Robert Fulghum, is about the most simple, but important, values we learn from a very early age. And we teach each other both young and old. Fulghum writes:

"Without realizing it, we fill important places in each other's lives. It's that way with a minister and congregation. Or, with the guy at the corner grocery, the mechanic at the local garage, the family doctor, teachers, neighbors, co-workers. Good people, who are always "there," who can be relied upon in small, important ways. People who teach us, bless us, encourage us, support us, uplift us in the dailiness of life. We never tell them. I don't know why, but we don't. And, of course, we fill that role ourselves. There are those who depend on us, watch us, learn from us, take from us. And we never know. Don't sell yourself short. You may never have proof of your importance, but you are more important than you think."

Let us be prepared to be good learners and teachers, as adults and as children. May the coming school year be a time in which we intensify our respectful and mutual relationships for learning and growing.

Mensaje del P. Andy: El nuevo año escolar comenzará pronto: 29 de agosto para las escuelas católicas GRACE y 5 de septiembre para las escuelas públicas de Green Bay. Los estudiantes, administradores, maestros y personal están empezando a pensar en el nuevo año. Cada uno de estos grupos tiene su propio papel: aprender, organizar, enseñar y mantener el orden y la limpieza. Oramos para que cada uno pueda cumplir su papel con éxito y con gran respeto por los roles de los demás.

Cada experiencia y encuentro es una oportunidad para aprender. Los niños que aprenden a caminar hacia y desde la escuela y / o a viajar en autobuses o compartir viajes con otras familias es una oportunidad de aprendizaje. Todos los involucrados tendrán la oportunidad de coordinar horarios, compartir espacios en automóviles y autobuses, obedecer a los guardias de cruce, velar por la seguridad de los demás, lidiar con diferentes tipos de clima y ser amables y pacientes entre sí, ya que muchas personas llegan juntas a la escuela al mismo tiempo, etc. Todos estos momentos pueden ser momentos importantes de aprendizaje, incluso tan importantes como las matemáticas, la lectura, la escritura, la historia y las artes del lenguaje. Los padres, conductores de autobuses, conductores de autos compartidos, maestros, personal de seguridad y muchos otros aprenderán al mismo tiempo que los estudiantes aprenden. A medida que estos adultos aprenden, están enseñando a las niñas y niños cómo aprender de la vida diaria.

Aprender a ser un joven respetuoso requiere que los adultos sean buenos ejemplos. El libro titulado, *Todo lo que Necesito Saber Aprendí en el Kindergarten*, de Robert Fulghum, trata sobre los valores más simples, pero importantes, que aprendemos desde una edad muy temprana. Y nos enseñamos unos a otros tanto jóvenes como mayores. Fulghum escribe:

"Sin darnos cuenta, ocupamos lugares importantes en la vida de los demás. Es así con un ministro y una congregación. O, con el chico de la tienda de comestibles de la esquina, el mecánico en el garage local, el médico de familia, maestros, vecinos, compañeros de trabajo. Buenas personas, que siempre están "ahí", en las que se puede confiar de maneras pequeñas e importantes. Personas que nos enseñan, nos bendicen, nos animan, nos apoyan, nos elevan en la cotidianidad de la vida. Nunca se lo decimos. No sé por qué, pero no lo sabemos. Y, por supuesto, nosotros mismos cumplimos ese papel. Hay quienes dependen de nosotros, nos observan, aprenden de nosotros, nos quitan. Y nunca lo sabemos. No te vendas corto. Puede que nunca tengas pruebas de tu importancia, pero eres más importante de lo que piensas".

Estemos preparados para ser buenos estudiantes y maestros, como adultos y como niños. Que el próximo año escolar sea un tiempo en el que intensifiquemos nuestras relaciones respetuosas y mutuas para aprender y crecer.
