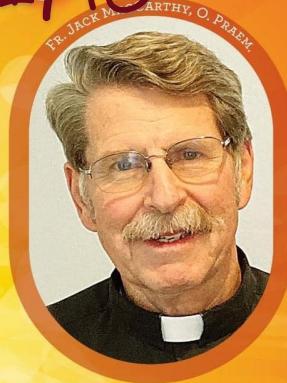
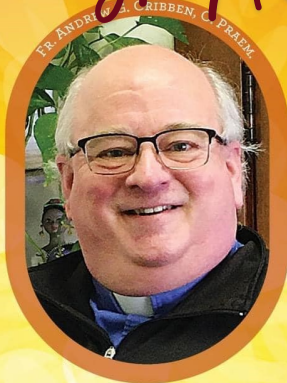

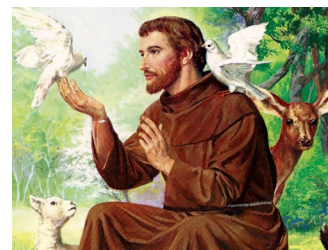

**Message from Fr. Andy:** Jesus says, “love one another as I have loved you.” This last commandment summarizes his life. Jesus calls it a “new” commandment. It is new because no one has lived and loved as the Messiah, our Savior Jesus the Christ, lived and loved. He taught us something NEW. Now, we who bear the name of Christ as Christians, and who hold Jesus as our model of life, must do an honest assessment about how we are living this commandment.

How do we demonstrate that we love one another in Christ-like ways? Are we ready to sacrifice, to give up something of ourselves, for the good of another? That is how Jesus loved. He lived *agape*-love. Members of families must sacrifice personally for the good of the whole family. Spouses make sacrifices for the good of each other. Members of faith communities, like St. Willebrord Parish, sacrifice for the good of the community. We build up God’s kingdom by applying Christian values in our relationships. We even make sacrifices for people we do not know so that they can know and love God as well as we ourselves know and love God.

Each person is given the opportunity to love as a member of a community. As baptized members of the Catholic Church, we are sons and daughters of God, and brothers and sisters to one another. We are to love one another in the Church, the Body of Christ, the People of God. The Apostle John writes: “*We love, because He first loved us. If someone says, “I love God,” and yet he hates his brother or sister, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother and sister whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God must also love his brother and sister.*” (1 John 4:20-21)

As a son or daughter of our parents, we are to love them. As a mother or father of children, we are to love them. As a husband or wife, we are to love our spouse. As a single woman or man, we are to love one another. As an uncle or aunt, as a niece or nephew, as a cousin as a brother in law or sister in law, as a friend, as a stranger, and in every kind of relationship we can imagine, we are commanded to love.

Love is demonstrated in actions of care, compassion, kindness, and forgiveness. We cannot love in theory. We must really love. We must truly be charitable. We must collaborate with one another for the greatest good. Let us love one another in ways that change our divided world and communities. Love never fails!

**Mensaje del P. Andy:** Jesús dice: "Ámense los unos a los otros como yo los he amado". Este último mandamiento resume su vida. Jesús lo llama un mandamiento "nuevo". Es nuevo porque nadie ha vivido y amado como el Mesías, nuestro Salvador Jesús el Cristo, vivió y amó. Él nos enseñó algo NUEVO. Ahora, nosotros que llevamos el nombre de Cristo como cristianos, y que tenemos a Jesús como nuestro modelo de vida, debemos hacer una evaluación honesta acerca de cómo estamos viviendo este mandamiento.

¿Cómo demostramos que nos amamos unos a otros de maneras semejantes a las de Cristo? ¿Estamos dispuestos a sacrificarnos, a renunciar a algo de nosotros mismos, por el bien de otro? Así es como Jesús amó. Vivió el amor-*ágape*. Los miembros de las familias deben sacrificarse personalmente por el bien de toda la familia. Los cónyuges hacen sacrificios por el bien del otro. Los miembros de las comunidades de fe, como la parroquia de St. Willebrord, se sacrifican por el bien de la comunidad. Edificamos el reino de Dios aplicando valores cristianos en nuestras relaciones. Incluso hacemos sacrificios por personas que no conocemos para que puedan conocer y amar a Dios, así como nosotros mismos conocemos y amamos a Dios.

A cada persona se le da la oportunidad de amar como miembro de una comunidad. Como miembros bautizados de la Iglesia Católica, somos hijos e hijas de Dios, y hermanos y hermanas unos para otros. Debemos amarnos unos a otros en la Iglesia, el Cuerpo de Cristo, el Pueblo de Dios. El apóstol Juan escribe: “*Si alguno dice: Yo amo a Dios, y aborrece a su hermano, es un mentiroso; porque el que no ama a su hermano, a quien ha visto, no puede amar a Dios a quien no ha visto. Y este mandamiento tenemos de Él: que el que ama a Dios, ame también a su hermano.*” (1Juan 4,20-21)

Como hijo o hija de nuestros padres, debemos amarlos. Como madre o padre de hijos, debemos amarlos. Como esposo o esposa, debemos amar a nuestro cónyuge. Como mujer u hombre solteros, debemos amarnos unos a otros. Como tío o tía, como sobrina o sobrino, como primo o prima, como cuñado o cuñada, como amigo, como extraño, y en todo tipo de relación que podamos imaginar, se nos ordena amar.

El amor se demuestra en acciones de cuidado, compasión, bondad y perdón. No podemos amar en teoría. Debemos amar de verdad. Debemos ser verdaderamente caritativos. Debemos colaborar unos con otros por el mayor bien. Amémonos unos a otros de maneras que cambien nuestro mundo y comunidades divididos. ¡El amor nunca falla!
